Noted for its typical Mesoamerican architectural designs and architecture, El Castillo was in fact constructed atop another much smaller temple. And these days, at the base of its northern stairway, tourists can easily go into a tunnel into its inner temples. To this day, the small room situated on the top of the staircase still has The Jaguar Throne, that is carved from stone while painted blood red with exquisite jade green spots.

Regardless of whether you visit Chichen Itza on your own or you have your family and friends along with you, getting to the site if you come from Cancun is rather simple.
